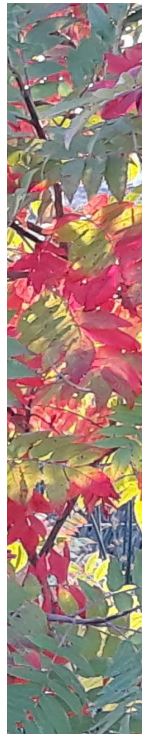


Things FALL in the Autumn!
